In the framework of EUSAIR Flagship of Pillar 2 on Transport 'Adriatic-Ionian green-smart port hub concepts', the Conference seeks to foster a focused and open discussion on how digital solutions can help improve the management of rail operations and enhance the efficiency of interconnections between inland and port terminals, stimulating dialogue across the entire EUSAIR port system in the Adriatic-Ionian basin.

HOW TO ARRIVE

By plane:

The closest airport to Ravenna is Bologna Airport (BLQ). From there you can take Marconi Express to the Central Station of Bologna, and proceed by train to Ravenna.

By train:

The Port Authority is a 10-minute walk from Ravenna train station. Just take the “Darsena” exit which is opposite the main exit.

By car:

The Port Authority is easy to reach by car avoiding the city centre. However, there might not be enough parking space for all the guests attending. In addition to the Port Authority’s parking, there are some parking spots along Via Teodorico street.
